



REFERRAL GUIDANCE:

It is expected that suitable referrals to FCT will be the equivalent of Tier 2 cases for the NHS. There will usually be a single problem involving the child or children and their family. FCT does not deal with cases involving personality disorder or possible psychosis. Cases FCT may help with could involve mild obsessive behavior, anxiety, depression, anger issues, bullying or aggression which does not involve police action. There will be no immediate risk to life or to others.

Please note that Tier 2 cases can also be referred to CAMHS. Active self harm, severe eating disorders and child protection issues will usually require Tier 3 CAMHS services. Referrals of Looked-After children cannot be accepted by FCT as very specific criteria have to be met to satisfy local authorities in whose care they are. The family income will be estimated to be in one of three bands which will affect family contributions towards counselling.
